International Conference on the Future of US-China Economic Relations

The University of California, Santa Barbara (UCSB) Confucius Institute and the UCSB Department of Political Science are jointly organizing "The International Conference on the Future of US-China Economic Relations" which will take place on February 10~11, 2017 at the UCSB campus.

The conference intends to bring together leading scholars from China and the United States, representing a wide range of research programs, to exchange ideas on the study of current issues in US-China economic relations. Particular emphasis will be placed on the political economy of trade and financial relations as well as regional and global issues. We will also welcome perspectives from international relations that shed light on US-China economic diplomacy.

Conference Panels

The conference will feature three panels:

- **Panel I:** Monetary and Financial Issues. Topics will include China's role in global financial markets, Chinese monetary policy and exchange rate policy, RMB internationalization, and financial reforms in China.
- **Panel II:** US-China Trade Policy. Topics will include bilateral trade conflicts, the role of China's new "normal" economy in the world economy, global supply chains, and regional and global trade policy issues.
- **Panel III:** US, China, and Global and Regional Economic Institutions. Topics will include G20, IMF, World Bank, WTO and global governance; AIIB, the new Silk Road project (One-Belt, One-Road), TPP, and other topics related to economic diplomacy and regional and global governance.

Call for Papers

We would like to invite submissions of papers/proposals that investigate topics in future US-China economic relations. The deadline for proposal/abstract submission is October 22, 2016. The conference review committee will review and notify the author no later than November 1.
